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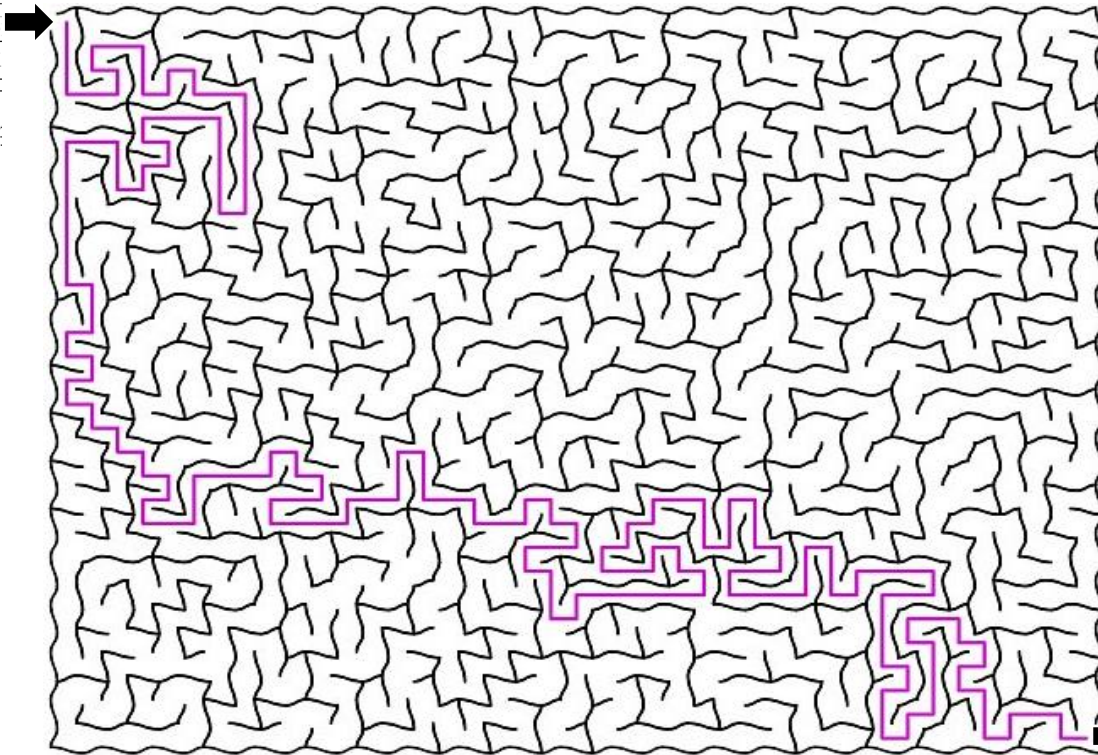

Guilt	Joseph's brothers had to face up to all the wrong things they'd done to Joseph and their dad.
Helplessness	Joseph had the perfect opportunity and motive for revenge but he chose to forgive.
Making a difference	Joseph treated his brothers kindly and arranged for them to live in the best part of Egypt.
Unnoticed	Jacob's family were happily reunited and celebrated.
